



Maybelle Brow Aftercare

Post Procedural Care for Eyebrows

Day of Procedure:

Please wash your hands with antibacterial soap before ever touching your new Microbladed eyebrows. When washing your eyebrows, use lukewarm water, and gentle cleansing or antibacterial soap. Using your fingertips only, get a sudsy bubble lather going and in a circular motion, cleanse your brows for up to a minute. Rinse with lukewarm water and gently pat dry with a paper towel only. Once completely dry, apply a THIN layer of Micro balm to each brow. Perform this process before bed.

Days 2-7:

Wash your brows using the same technique as listed above, both morning and before bed. Keep eyebrows lightly glossed with Skin Candy three to four times a day for the next week. Do not overuse the Skin Candy, do not suffocate your brows and do not use any other products on your eyebrows.

- Do not use any Retinal, Retin A, Glycolic Acids, Peroxide, Neosporin or other unspecified oils on your brows or brow area during your healing period of four weeks.
- Do not scrub, itch or pick your flaking scabs or eyebrows.
- Do not expose the area to the sun or tanning beds! Must wear a Hat to cover brows from the sun. After healing process is complete, use minimum of SPF30 sunblock on your eyebrows to prevent premature fading.
- Avoid facials, face massages, lash extensions, brow waxing, spray tanning, swimming, steam rooms and saunas for at least a week after the procedure.

- Do not exercise the first three to five days of your new Microbladed brows! No heavy or excessive sweating for at least seven days. Absolutely NO HOT YOGA!
- No makeup is to be used on or near your brow area until your brows have finished the scabbing and flaking process. (Brows will appear very light, typically takes 1-2 weeks)
- Do not tint or dye your eyebrows for two weeks after procedure.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF PIGMENTS.

What to expect after your Microblading/Shading Eyebrow

- Slight swelling, redness and your brows will appear sharp, dark and bold immediately after the procedure and possibly for the next two days after.
- It is normal to lose approximately 1/3 of the color during the healing process as it is filtered throughout the skin. If you wish to go darker for your Brow Refresher, please advise Meagan at the time of your next appointment.
- After the initial procedure, the color will appear to be a shade or two, too dark because naturally blood has risen to the surface and the pigment is sitting on top of your dermal layer. In six to eight days it will appear very light, in some cases it may look as if the strokes have completely disappeared. Around ten to twelve days the color will start to resurface and show more, once all the dead skin exfoliates itself off your brow area and you should be able to see your final color between weeks three and four.
- Your brows will appear softer and less harsh once completely healed because the color has filtered from the dermal layer of the skin to the epidermis.
- **Please be patient** throughout your healing period. Healing takes up to thirty (30) days.

- During your optional, but **highly recommended**, Brow Refresher appointment, more areas can be filled in and incomplete hair strokes can be refreshed to make your eyebrows look fuller and more 3D like.

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Your brows will be approximately 20% to 25% darker, bolder and also thicker in width than they will be, once they are healed. Your skin will appear red under the pigment which causes the true color of the pigment to appear darker and warmer in tone. You may be experiencing tenderness and some minor swelling; this will subside by the following day. Natural Exfoliation, which will begin in the next few days, will cause excess pigment surrounding the eyebrow area to scab and flake away. Your brows will then appear more narrow and softer. Don't judge your brows throughout your healing process, for you will go through many stages (some ugly, some itchy). This is all part of the process!
